What is the Green Circle Trail?

New residents relocating from surrounding areas may not know that it is a 30.5 mile nature trail that circles through and around the Plover/Stevens Point area.

It is a living sanctuary of river shores, trees, wild birds and animals recalling the history of huge pineries, pioneer settlements and lore of the Wisconsin and Plover Rivers.

The Green Circle Trail is a co-operative effort, bringing together all the neighboring municipalities, people of Portage County and visitors in the unifying spirit of nature, history, wellness and enjoyment.

It has been made possible by the support of private landowners, local governmental units, the Business Council, UW-SP, public utilities, state and federal agencies and the vision of



the citizens of our great community. It took over 10 years to build from conception to completion.

The Green Circle Trail is for residents and visitors of all ages. It places natural areas at

our doorstep for hiking, biking, jogging, cross-country skiing, canoeing, wildlife watching, fishing, family outings, and just plain solitude.

If you go, there are not many rules—just plain common sense. No motorized vehicles are allowed and dogs must be on a 8 ft leash and controlled. Remember to stay on the trails; slow walkers and runners keep to the right.

Now that the weather is finally user friendly, it's the time to put away your snow shoes and break in your new hiking boots. On your way out, stop by the clubhouse and pick up a map.

Only in America.... Why do people order double cheeseburgers, large fries, and a diet coke?

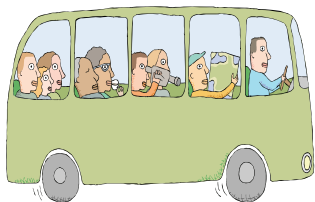
Only in America.... Why do banks leave both doors open and then chain the pens to the counters?

- 1 medium steak

Taxi service is available to all Village of Plover residents. The fee is as follows: \$1.00 each way for seniors, disabled, and children. \$2.00 each way for everyone else. The taxi will take you anywhere within village limits for the above fee. Outside the village there is an additional fee of \$1.00 per mile. The approx. boundaries are HH (North), Grant Ave (West), Crossroad Commons (East), and Hwy. 54 (South). No advance notice is necessary, but a 24 hour notice is suggested for a wheelchair.
