## RECIPE CORNER

### Chocolate Chip Zucchini Bread

#### Ingredients:

4 Tbsp cocoa, 1/2 to 1 package chocolate chips, 3 eggs, 1 cup oil (or applesauce), 2 -1/4 cup sugar, 2 cups grated zucchini, 3 tsp. vanilla, 2 -1/2 cup flour, 1/4 tsp. baking powder, 1 tsp. salt, 1 tsp. baking soda, 3 tsp. cinnamon, 1 cup chopped nuts (optional)

Grease and flour pans. Bake 325 degrees. Bake for 45-60 minutes. Makes 2 loaves.
